



## TERMS&CONDITIONS

“Scrigno & Me” is an initiative promoted by SCRIGNO SPA Unipersonale with registered offices in Via Casale, 975 - 47822 - S. Ermete di Santarcangelo di Romagna (RN), Italy, tax code no. 03145720409, VAT no. 03145720409 and Rimini Business Register no. RN 03145720409 (herein referred to as “Scrigno” or the “Promoter”).

Participation in the initiative is dependent on participants unconditionally accepting all the clauses of these Terms & Conditions as established below.

### 1) Objective of the initiative

The objective of the initiative is to select projects to be used in magazines, catalogues and web pages to showcase real “product use” and reward participants’ creativity by selecting projects that have been realised using Scrigno products.

### 2) Initiative timescale

The “Scrigno & Me” initiative has the following timescale:

- a. registration for the initiative opens on 15.03.2018 and closes on 15.09.2018: contributions must be submitted between those dates;
- b. final selection by the panel of judges by 15.10.2018

### 3) Target groups

The initiative is open to architects, surveyors and interior designers (herein referred to as “participants”) with a VAT number and aged 18 or older at the date of entry.

Participants should upload a project created using Scrigno products to the initiative’s special website, following the instructions given below.

All of the Promoter’s employees are excluded from participation.

### 4) Registration/participation in the initiative

To participate in the initiative, the above target groups should connect to [www.scrignoandme.com](http://www.scrignoandme.com) between 15.03.2018 and 15.09.2018 and input their email address in the specifically dedicated area, flagging their explicit authorisation relating to privacy issues; after this, they will receive a test email to check the email address input, along with an access password.

Once access has been made, participants must complete the initiative registration form that contains the following information:

- language selected
- personal details: name, surname, telephone number, profession (predefined list)
- company details: company name, full address, telephone number, website, firm description, photo of the firm or the architect
- Scrigno products used for the project (predefined list)

Once registration has been completed, thanks to a special web application, participants should input their project, giving a relevant description, the year it was created and its location, as well as photographs of the project itself.

It is specified that:

- at any time, but by 15.09.2018 at the latest, participants can edit their projects and make changes to it;
- a competent subject, a so-called “moderator” chosen directly by the Promoter, will ascertain that the project is relevant to the initiative, eliminating any projects not compliant with these Terms & Conditions;
- each participant can upload more than one project as there is no limit to the number of projects that can be uploaded

### **5) Final selection by a panel of judges**

Once the participation deadline has passed, all valid projects will be studied by a panel of judges that, based on their own personal opinion, will determine the top 10 most-voted projects. These projects will once again be assessed by the panel of judges that will then select the best 3 that will be awarded the following prizes:

- first prize: 5.000 euro
- second prize: 3.000 euro
- third prize: 2.000 euro

All the projects participating in the initiative can be used by Scigno for publication in magazines and catalogues and on web pages and social media networks to showcase real “product use”.

As well as the winning projects, the panel of judges will choose 3 reserve projects to be used, in order of selection, in the following circumstances:

- if any of the winners cannot be contacted
- failure to receive or delayed receipt of any documents requested
- non-compliant documents received and/or documents received after the deadline
- failed confirmation following the assessment carried out on the data input by the winner
- fake data input
- failure to comply with these Terms&Conditions.

It is specified that:

- in the event of a draw, to declare the winner and/or the reserves the panel of judges will go through the assessment/selection procedure again
- if a win is not confirmed it will be forfeited and the ranked position will slip back
- the winners must issue an invoice for the amount corresponding to the prize they have won, which will be subject to legal VAT and tax withholdings, both so they can receive the prize and comply with the above tax formalities.

When selected, projects will be anonymous and therefore, the panel of judges will be unaware of any details relating to the participants.

The panel of judges will assess the projects, taking into account the following assessment criteria:

1. integration of the products in the mood of the project
2. enhancement of the products
3. innovative use of the products and relevant finishes

The panel of judges will consist in no fewer than 3 members and their decisions in assessing the projects will be final and binding.

Winning projects will be selected by the panel of judges by 15.10.2018 at the offices of Scrigno Spa Unipersonale.

#### *Notifying the 3 winning finalists selected*

Notification will be sent to winners by email with a request to submit a copy of their valid identity document (front and back) to check the truthfulness of the details input on the registration form.

Should any winner not reply to such notification within 5 days of the date of the winning mail/notice being sent, the participant concerned will be considered untraceable and the first available reserve will be contacted. The same win notification criteria will be used for reserves.

#### **6) General explanations**

No purchase is needed to take part in the initiative.

Each participant can only register once for the initiative, although an unlimited number of projects can be uploaded for the duration of the initiative. However, each participant can win no more than one prize.

The Promoter reserves the right to verify the origin of the projects and ensure they can be attributed to the relevant participant, requesting the latter to submit a copy of a valid identity document. Should the Promoter note any failure to comply with participation terms and conditions, it will exclude the participant from the initiative.

Projects that cannot be correctly visualized, are illegible and/or are damaged or any that show other company brands/logos will not be deemed valid.

By accepting these Terms and Conditions, all participants:

- undertake not to upload projects/photographs that show people or animals;
- declare owning copyright to the project uploaded and authorise publication of the same;
- accept responsibility for and undertake not to upload projects/photographs he/she does not own the right to use and image rights to the items represented;
- undertake not to use the present initiative to disseminate content that could be false and/or defamatory, libellous, untrue, inexact, vulgar, odious, vexatious, obscene, religiously offensive, of a sexual nature, threatening and/or contrary to any legislation and/or contrary to good custom and public order and not compliant with existing applicable law.

Projects will be subject to the final and binding judgement of the Promoter or any third party entrusted by the Promoter, that should the criteria described above be deemed not to have been complied with, reserves the right to not allow whatever has been uploaded; projects will be removed if they contain: nudity, lecherous or vulgar content, items and content detrimental to the rights of others, including the right to privacy, publicity or third-party intellectual property rights; copyrights, brands or any other right that needs to be safeguarded or is owned by a third party; violence, drugs, tobacco, slanderous or defamatory material; fanaticism, racism; promotion of discrimination based on race, sex, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, age or any other condition protected by law. Material that is illegal, detrimental to image, in breach of or contrary to law will not be considered. Any denigrating action against the Promoter or any other person or group affiliated to the initiative will not be taken into consideration;

- undertake not to upload any material protected by copyright and/or detrimental to any third-party intellectual property rights (brands, patents, design, etc.), unless the participant owns the relevant right;
- accept direct responsibility for the projects uploaded, waiving the Promoter and/or the organisers of the initiative of any responsibility; in any case, they release from liability the Promoter and organisers of the initiative of any request advanced by third parties in relation to ownership of copyright and any other right connected to the contribution uploaded.
- acknowledge that there will be no right to any compensation relating to the possible publication of the projects uploaded.

It is further specified that:

- the Promoter can use the firm, projects and relevant photographs on its website and/or social media pages, in order to showcase real “product use” and give visibility to the firm that created them;
- participants and winners cannot demand rights on publication of the projects they uploaded;
- the Promoter does not accept responsibility for any projects not successfully uploaded due to connection/access failure problems or for any other reason not attributable to it;
- the Promoter does not accept responsibility for problems linked to access failure, impediment, malfunction or any other problem concerning technical equipment, computers, cables, electronics, software and hardware, transmission and connection and telephone lines or any problems using the registration platform attributable to causes outside its direct control which could prevent participants accessing the Internet. Furthermore, it is not responsible for any viruses, IT damage or malware that could affect terminals used by participants to take part in this initiative;
- participation in the initiative does not incur any additional cost other than the cost of connection in the tariff plan of the Internet access provider used by each subscriber, which is at the expense of the participant;
- any reason that could lead to suspicion of fraud relating to the explicit aims of this initiative will afford the Promoter the right to not fulfil its obligations.

**7) Information on data protection pursuant to Art. 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003**

Data is collected in compliance with Legislative Decree no. 196/03, without prejudice in any case to the faculty of exercising the rights pursuant to Art. 7 of the aforementioned Legislative Decree.
